Finders ships first cathode from Wetar

PERTH (miningweekly.com) – ASX-listed Finders Resources has shipped its first copper cathode from its Wetar Island project, in Indonesia.

The shipment of some 102.5 t of copper cathode was expected to arrive at its destination at the end of May.

Finders told shareholders on Thursday that its solvent extraction electrowinning plant at Weter was operating at its nameplate capacity of 3 000 t/y of copper cathode.

Finders was in the midst of expanding the project to produce some 28 000 t/y of copper cathode, recently announcing that it had secured \$210-million in funding.
